AMBULATORY MEDICAL ONCOLOGY - ROTATION DESCRIPTION

The emphasis of the Medical Oncology rotation is the educational experience of the resident and the goals of the rotation are to increase the resident's knowledge regarding:

- 1) Indications and treatment options for common cancers
- 2) The management of common complications of cancer and its therapies.

The rotation will be based in the outpatient setting with a smaller component of inpatient responsibility related to the Consult service. Residents will attend 6-7 site specific outpatient clinics per week with emphasis on the most common malignancies. Trainees will be involved in the assessment of newly referred patients as well as those on treatment and in developing appropriate management and treatment plans. Residents will also be expected to participate in Oncology teaching sessions and multidisciplinary rounds to broaden their experience.

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
